~ ALL-AROUND DANCER AWARDS ~

This award is sponsored by the **Thunder Bay Society of Ballet and Dance** and is presented to a Junior and a Senior participant who excels in a combination of various forms of dance. These dancers show versatility as true performers by possessing the self-confidence to perform independently; and at the same time, strive to reach their highest potential in a collective group effort.

Both, the Junior All-Around Award and the Senior All-Around Award can only be won ONCE by an individual dancer while he/she is competing in each Division. The applicant must be attending regular dance classes in the Thunder Bay District for a period of no less than one dance season prior to competition; and must not be enrolled at an out of town educational facility or have been regularly attending dance classes out of the Thunder Bay District; and must possess a current Society Student Membership in order to be declared an Award winner.

Each Division winner must have the highest total mark by combining three (3) marks received when participating in three (3) separate dance forms; and all marks entered on the application form must be accurate and in accordance to the guidelines detailed below to qualify as an admissible application.

DIVISIONS:

JUNIOR ALL AROUND DANCER includes the following Age Categories: 8 & Under, 10 & Under and 12 & Under.

* Only marks received in Junior Division Age Categories will be recognized for this Award.

SENIOR ALL AROUND DANCER includes the following Age Categories: 14 & Under, 16 & Under and 18 & Under.

* Only marks received in Senior Division Age Categories will be recognized for this Award.

*The only time an exception to this rule will be considered is when a dancer is in the transition period between the Junior and Senior Division and his/her ONLY BALLET performance happens to fall into the older or younger division. Otherwise, all marks must be received for performances in the applicant's own Age Division.

DANCE FORM REQUIREMENT:

The **1st mark** entered must have been received for a **Ballet** performance in Pointe, Demi-Pointe, or Demi-Pointe/Pointe-Character.

The **2nd and 3rd marks** entered can be for performances in Tap, Jazz, Acro, Character, Modern, Contemporary, Lyrical, Hip Hop, Cabaret, National, Musical Theatre, Song & Dance and/or Open; however, each dance form/discipline can only be used ONCE.

A Dancer may only pick one entry out of the following categories, Cabaret, Musical Theatre, Song & Dance.

If using a Character Ballet mark, a dancer may NOT use a Character entry.

BREAKDOWN OF ELIGIBLE ENTRIES:

Entry #1: Dance Form: One of the acceptable Ballet categories listed above // Classification: Solo, Duet/Trio, Group or Line

Entry #2: Dance Form: Any discipline from the dance categories listed above (other than Ballet) // Classification: Solo, Duet/Trio, Group or Line

Entry #3: Dance Form: Any discipline not used in Entry #1 or Entry #2 // Classification: Solo, Duet/Trio, Group or Line

* **IMPORTANT REMINDER:** **ONE** of the **3 MARKS** entered must have been received for a **SOLO** performance; **ONE** of **3 MARKS** must have been received for a **GROUP OR LINE** performance, and the last MARK from any of **SOLO, DUET/TRIO, GROUP, or LINE** performances.



ALL-AROUND RUNNER-UP AWARDS

This award is sponsored by LMFA. The 12 winners (6 in each Division) of these T-Shirt awards are selected from Award applicants who have received the next highest combined top scores in each Division after Award winners have been declared.

This award is open to all Dance Competition participants. Competitors are not required to be a current Society member to submit an application for a Runner-Up T-Shirt Award; and all Festival participants can apply for a Runner-Up Award regardless of previous All-Around Dancer Award wins or past Runner-Up wins

Each application must be signed by the Studio Director or a Principal Teacher. Unendorsed applications will be automatically considered invalid. Also, the submission of any incorrect information will be grounds for disqualification for both the Awards and/or any Runner-Up Award.
